Turn left toward **Glen Oaks Drive**

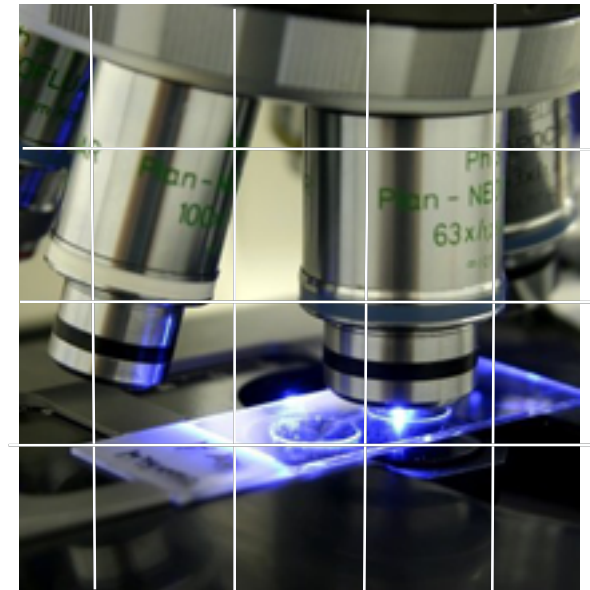
Turn right to **Glen Oaks Country Club**

Lawrence Burgart, MD practices with Allina Health and Minnesota Gastroenterology, a 35-member pathology group which serves a multi-hospital system and physician office practices. He is a Clinical Professor of Pathology at the University of Minnesota. Dr. Burgart is an Iowa native, and received degrees in biochemistry at Iowa State and medicine at the University of Iowa. He did a pathology residency at the University of Iowa and cites Drs. Robert Robinson and Frank Mitros as key influences. He matriculated to a GI/liver pathology fellowship at Mayo Clinic, Rochester and was on the Mayo Clinic faculty from 1994-2005. Dr. Burgart’s interests include molecular and diagnostic pathology of the GI tract, liver and pancreas. He has co-authored 160 papers in these areas.
